This required the Developer to pay over the sum of £22,320.69 as a financial contribution towards the offsite provision of sport space, £31,010.98 towards the off-site provision of children's play space and £10,133.60 towards the off-site provision of community facility space. It is the intention for these monies to be remitted to the Parish Council, upon the Parish Council entering into an appropriate form of Indemnity, for use for such purposes in accordance with the Section 106 Agreement that relates to securing the use of the monies in this manner
