### 19/4 PARKING AND SPEEDING CONCERNS

#### To draw up a short list of recommendations to Council on what to bid for in the Local Highways Improvement Fund

The Committee reviewed a log of incoming issues and concerns and recognised that to all of them would be easy to resolve or would fall within the requirements of the LHI scheme. It had also been confirmed that the PC had to make its bid for either Waterbeach or Chittering but not both.

After considered the entries on the log, it was **AGREED** to present a shortlist of 3 possibilities to the Parish Council as follows:

- Bannold Road/Denny End Road junction – proposal for a mini roundabout
- Lay by opposite the village stores/ area outside the Chinese – implementation of restricted parking provisions
- Way Lane – traffic calming measures, especially around Box Tree Cottage given that its residents were particularly affected by speeding cars.

The issue of a passing place at Chittering was already being pursued with SCDC in terms of enforcement of previously applied planning conditions

#### **Greenside bus stop marking(s)**

It was **AGREED** to recommend to Council that this work was funded directly by WPC to enable it to be undertaken at the same time as lining renewal work in the village expected during the summer.
