Both require different preparation and this is the reason it was put forward and put in the minutes at the sports meeting to go the full Parish Council Meeting suggesting that a new mower be purchased for the cricket pitch.

At the meeting it was thought that one could be purchased for approx £1500.

I await the committee's decision on the matter.
