CATEGORY AND DEFINITION					
Trees unsuitable for retention					
Category U	These in such condition that they cannot realistically be retained as living trees in the current land use for longer than 10 years				
Trees to be considered for retention					
Category A	Trees of high quality with an estimated remaining life expectancy of at least 40 years				
Category B	Trees of moderate quality with an estimated remaining life expectancy of at least 20 years				
Category C	Trees of low quality with an estimated remaining life expectancy of at least 10 years, or young trees with a stem diameter below 150mm
