Dear Liz,

I am writing as Treasurer of the Fen Edge Twinning Association to apply for a grant from Waterbeach Parish Council to assist with the funding of FETA 2016 project. Attached are the application form, FETA accounts for 2014-15 and copies of bank statements.

In May 2016, FETA will host a group from Avrillé, a small French town in the suburbs of Angers with whom Fen Edge villages have been twinned for over 16 years. During our visits to Avrillé, the local French committee, with the help from the Mairie, has been very welcoming with fine dining events and cultural visits. With the support from local parish councils, Fen Edge residents are keen to reciprocate by providing a welcoming and entertaining weekend.

The Three-day event will take place from 5<sup>th</sup> to 8<sup>th</sup> May, with a special dinner with a ceilidh on Saturday 7<sup>th</sup> May.

The cost of the event has been budgeted at £5,120, to be financed as below:

FETA own account\*: £2,170
Individual Hosts contributions: £1,750
Waterbeach Parish Council Grant £300
Funds from other grant applications\*\* £900
(Cottenham, Willingham, Rampton, FECA)

\*FETA main fundraising events are two quiz nights per year, taking place in November and March. These are taking place at Cottenham Village College and are open to anyone, gathering 80 to 100 people from all villages.

In 2016, additional fundraising events will include a New Year dinner, on  $23^{\rm rd}$  January 2016 at St Paul's, Cambridge.

\*\*We have based our grant requests on the numbers of families taking part from each village.

Besides the Twinning between the French and English communities, FETA brings together families from the Fen Edge villages: over the three-day weekend, hosts are opening their house to welcome guests from Avrillé, sharing traditions and reinforcing a sense of community. Strong friendships have been established between the families from Avrillé and the Fen Edge villages with children as young as four taking part in the twining.

The Twinning is an opportunity to bring several generations together with children discovering a new culture. During their visits, French guests have taken part enthusiastically in local events such as the Fun Run, enjoyed the local scenery and learned about local history exploring the Roman Car Dyke. You can find reports of past events on our FB page, Fen Edge Twinning Association.

During the last visit in 2014, a total of 34 families from the Fen Edge villages, including 7 families from Waterbeach, hosted guests from Avrillé. We are keen to make the Twinning weekend affordable to all, so support from local councils is important to us.

We would be very happy to welcome you at the Twinning dinner on 7<sup>th</sup> May so that you can experience first-hand the warm relationship between Avrillé and Fen Edge residents.

We hope you will receive our application favourably.
