'A Day at the Beach' –
weekends of 2/3, 9/10 and 16/17 July

We decided to put this event on after the huge success of our last 'Day at the Beach' in May 2014.

Instead of the Baptist Chapel, we chose the Barracks site because it is bigger, has a number of buildings perfect for use and is a site that has almost been forgotten by our village.

A good number of artists including painters, sculptors and photographers will display their work and there will also be talks by local authors, as well as a music event by local band 'Atomised', who are releasing an album at the same time.

Not only would we like to bring our work to the village but also to get the newcomers to Waterbeach interested in the Barracks before the history is lost and changed.

The Barracks have been hugely supportive, opening almost every building for us to use and are hoping to put a show on of local history at the same time as our show. They have advertised us in their last magazine which was sent to every house in Waterbeach (see enclosed copy).

We also plan to work with the local Primary School to run a workshop for children.

We hope this event will connect local people with art as well as bringing Open Studios visitors to Waterbeach, making them aware of the Barracks site, its facilities and its history.
