

For the attention of Cottenham Parish Council Clark,

I am writing as Treasurer of the Fen Edge Twinning Association to apply for a grant from Cottenham Parish Council to assist with the funding of our 2018 project. Attached are the application form and FETA accounts for 2016-17.

2018 sees the 20th anniversary of the twinning of the Fen Edge Villages (Cottenham, Rampton, Willingham, Landbeach & Waterbeach) with the town of Avrillé, near Angers in France. This is part of a major anniversary for Avrillé because it will also be the 25th anniversary of their twinning with the town of Ripollet in Spain and the 40th anniversary of their twinning with Schwalbach in Germany. Our French counterparts in Avrillé are planning a major event with joint cultural activities with both German and British groups guests of Avrillé over the May Day Bank Holiday weekend from 4<sup>th</sup> to 7<sup>th</sup> May.

After such a great success in 2016, we have been asked to organise for a Ceilidh band and caller to join our group. We are also encouraging the younger generation to take part through projects with local school.

Over the past 20 years, a strong friendship has grown up and we are keen to keep the Twinning spirit alive.

There will be an opportunity to forge links with Avrillé's German twin town, Schwalbach, in a significant centenary year in European history.

It is important for the maintenance of our twinning relationship that the trip is affordable to all; we will be offering free coach travel for children as well as reduced price to adults and free coach travel to the Ceilidh band, and the support from the local councils is important to use.

The cost of the event has been budgeted at £4,960, to be financed as below:
