Following on from the success of last year's 'Summer at the Beach' exhibition in July, we are in the process of organising a further event, involving a growing number of artists who live in Waterbeach. Last year was again a real success as it opened the Barracks doors once again to the village and it was wonderful to see people of all ages walking through those barriers enjoying the art and participating in the various workshops we held. Due to the uncertainty surrounding Waterbeach Village at the moment, we would like to bring some of the artwork out to the centre of the village and make the exhibition and events more of a celebration about our community, really showing off Waterbeach's talents and hopefully reaching out to even more residents.

We need your help to do this as every penny you have given us in the past has helped us to create this positive use of our Barracks. Without this funding, the event would be far less successful and this year we really want to celebrate all that is wonderful about our village.

The money you gave us helped us also to invite local authors to hold a talk about their work and we held a huge book swap with all proceeds donated to a Nepalese orphanage. We also organised a model railway, comedy events and a screening of 'Stuart A Life Backwards' – a film starring Benedict Cumberbatch and Tom Hardy about a young man who lived in Waterbeach and tragically died here. All donations were given to Emmaus. There were many more events held during the 3 weeks but it ended with the Local Beach Sessions bringing our Summer at the Beach to a dynamic climax with an outdoor music festival which was hugely attended and enjoyed.
