The monies are primarily intended to purchase new books on the reading challenge theme and the associated medals, certificates rewards and booklets etc (no longer entirely supplied by CCC). In 2019 the theme is "Inspired by the 50th anniversary of the moon landing, the theme of the 2019 Summer Reading Challenge is Space Chase ." Some monies will be used to replace some of the much-loved/well used picture books and some monies will provide some specific books to support school projects or notable events.
b) Who will benefit from the proposed project or scheme and how many of these are Cam residents? All residents of Waterbeach and the surroundings who use the library will benefit from the new books. In 2018 there were over 650 active borrowers and 95 users joined at the library including 61 new junior users. Anyone with a Cambridgeshire County Council card can use the library,

Waterbeach Library has continued to increase its number of active readers and books issued (unlike many libraries). There may be a contraction in 2019 due to reduced opening hours while the building works at the school are ongoing but it is essential to encourage children to keep reading during the holidays and to provide resources for children's project work. WILL strives to do this and put on relevant displays of new books for junior, young adult and adult readers.

The 2018 visitor counts have not been uploaded on to the CCC system despite being taken and sent in as instructed. Based on the fuligures we have the annual visitor total for 2018-2019 us likely to be 8000. (O1 count was 160 users with no special events)
