Hope you are well.

The summary of the proposal is set out in the application covering letter.(reproduced below)

Not sure I can summarise it any better.

- Minor amendments to the pedestrian / cycle access to the western edge of Parcel P1. This change is to move the ped/cycle link 1.5 m southwards to ensure it is coordinated with the detailed layout of the Parcel (subject to a separate RMA – 21/02400/REM)
- Amendments to the landscape design for the cross parcel permeability route for Parcel 2.1. The changes are minor in nature to ensure that the landscaping and planting is coordinated with the final design for Substation 1 (details for Substation 1 are subject to a separate RMA).
- Amendments to the design of the east west primary pedestrian and cycle route and north south secondary pedestrian and cycle route extending through Waterbeach Woods. These design changes are to maximise the retention of existing trees within the woods which can be achieved through the revised design.

In my view these are non-material amendments to the wider permission.
