Notes

1. *A personal interest exists where a decision on a matter would affect to a greater extent than other people in the District -
 - (a) *the well-being, financial position, employment or business of a Councillor, a partner, relative or close friends;*
 - (c) *any corporate body in which those persons have a beneficial interest in a class of securities exceeding a nominal value of £5,000; or*
 - (d) *the Councillor's registerable financial and other interests.**
2. *A personal interest becomes a prejudicial interest where a member of the public (who has knowledge of the circumstances) would reasonable regard the Councillor's personal interest as being so significant that it is likely to prejudice the Councillor's judgement of the public interest.*
3. *Members are reminded that they need to sign a Declaration of Acceptance of Office form in the presence of the Clerk before they can attend the meeting.*
