 - (b) *any corporate body in which those persons have a beneficial interest in a class of securities exceeding a nominal value of £5,000; or*
 - (c) *the Committee Member's registerable financial and other interests.*
2. *A personal interest becomes a prejudicial interest where a member of the public (who has knowledge of the circumstances) would reasonably regard the Committee member's personal interest as being so significant that it is likely to prejudice the member's judgement of the public interest.*
