

Waterbeach Day Centre

Waterbeach Day Centre is very grateful for the recent grant of £2,000 from Waterbeach Parish Council.

The Centre operates twice a week, on Mondays and Wednesdays, from 11am to 3pm, in the Denson Close Community Room. During that time, members can chat, play dominoes, bingo, and a range of other activities as they prefer. Coffee is available in the morning, a freshly cooked 2-course lunch is served, with tea and cakes before leaving in the afternoon.

We also arrange days out to places such as Garden Centres, we always have a Christmas party, and we like to plan other occasions, such as a Strawberry Tea or an Easter Egg Bingo.

Any resident of Waterbeach and the surrounding villages, of retirement age, is welcome to join the Day Centre, and to attend on Mondays or Wednesdays or on both days.

The cost of attending the Day Centre is subsidised for members (currently £5), and the remainder of the costs are met partly from member fund-raising events and partly from grants. Our costs have recently increased considerably as South Cambridgeshire District Council has started to charge us rent for using the Community Room. The grant from the Parish Council will enable us to upgrade our facilities (new saucepans, crockery, cutlery, etc.) and to continue to offer subsidised lunches for our members.

We can arrange transport for any member who lives further away or would otherwise find it difficult to get to the Community Room.
