23/27 WATERBEACH LIBRARY STATEMENT

After a brief discussion it was **proposed** by Cllr Rabbett, seconded by Cllr J Williams and **RESOLVED** by a unanimous vote to approve a statement about the Waterbeach Library and the position of Waterbeach Parish Council as follows:

Waterbeach Community Primary School (the school) has informed Waterbeach Parish Council, that following a buildings inspection, the portable building currently being used as Waterbeach Independent Lending Library (WILL) is in a poor state of repair. The school has concluded that the building is beyond economical repair and concluded that its continued use is not viable and that they require WILL to quit the premises within the next two years but definitely three years.

Waterbeach Parish Council values WILL and all volunteers who run it and will be looking for alternative premises.
