Dear Jonathan & Rob,

As you are aware I attended the multi-agency meeting at South Cambridgeshire District Council on 29th September 2015 in respect of the flooding problems at Bannold Road, Waterbeach. The meeting was also attended by Councillor Hockney and Councillor Johnson who represent Waterbeach, Pat Matthews and Andrew Newton from the IDB. I explained that I understood that AWS has scheduled AWS contractors Claret to carry out a survey of the section of the foul sewer at Bannold Road, Waterbeach where problems of surcharging have recently been experienced by residents in times of heavy rainfall.

The group requested that AWS provides more information as to the scope of the proposed survey as well as an indication of the timescale for its completion. The group also requested that the breadth of the survey be set to assesses the extent of any ground water infiltration, surface water contributions as well as any cross connections to the AWS foul system that may be contributing to the surcharging problems in times of heavy rainfall. It was also requested that the findings of the survey be shared with the group.

The group also requested that once Claret has completed the scheduled survey of the foul system and the results made known, a site meeting be arranged between the district councillors, the relevant representatives from CCC and SCDC and AWS personnel to obtain a clearer understanding of the problems that may cause flooding in times of heavy rainfall events and what will be done to resolve them. The group expressed their concern and frustration that this situation is arising and they wanted to establish what pressure could be applied by both South Cambridgeshire District Council and Cambridgeshire County Council towards resolving this matter.

In view of the above, can you please provide me with the necessary information as to the scope of the planned Claret survey of the foul system prior to it taking place as well dates when you are available to meet on site with me and the other members of the group once the findings of the survey are known and made available?

I am grateful for you cooperation in respect of this matter.
