

District Councillors report October 2015

Station Car Park

Network Rail have still not responded despite my many e-mails so I have asked our MP Lucy Frazer to help, she has contacts with Network Rail before so maybe this will help, I do appreciate that a lot of this is affected by the building of Cambridge North station.

Speedwatch

Our first exercise took place on Friday 2nd October along Cambridge Road from 08.00hrs to 10.00hrs, for the first hour Brian Robins was with us using a hand held radar gun while we had the usual Speed watch kit, approx. 150 cars passed but only two were going at a reportable speed, 1 x 36mph and 1 x 38mph. One driver gave rude signs but Brian had his number so he will get a letter, a little shouting from motorists but by and large everyone slowed down when they saw us at the side of the road. We are now planning our next exercise which will probably be in the school area.

Drainage & Flooding
