## **Bowls Pavilion**

I write as a team captain of the Beach Bowls Club. As you know bowls players have the use of the pavilion adjacent to the green on the Waterbeach Recreation Ground. This was erected by the Parish Council about 20 years ago. Not surprisingly the need for repairs has arisen. Whilst attention to these by the Parish Council is requested it has made us consider how this essential facility could be improved. In the Cambridge and District League the home team provides refreshment after the game. This happens usually in pavilions next to the green. Unfortunately we cannot do so because ours is too small. Whilst we make use of the Beach Social Club this is not ideal as we cannot be provided with a separate room and involves walking to another building.

Bearing in mind that we have regained a place in the first division it really is appropriate that we should provide hospitality in suitable premises overlooking our bowls green. We therefore request that the Parish Council provide funds to enable a suitable extension to be constructed. I appreciate that details of what is required need to be presented and will naturally do so if the principle can be accepted by the Council. We shall be happy to meet with Councillors or to attend any appropriate committee meeting.

Whilst we hope that the Parish Council will offer all necessary help we shall investigate other means of financial assistance. The Bowls club will be celebrating our centenary in less than ten years time and we wish to be able to do so that by having suitable accommodation.
