

Acting Parish Clerk Report – February 2017

Tillage Hall

Cameras and cages have been replaced and insurance claim filed.

Goal Posts

Work will start on Monday 6 February.

Sign Posts

Sign arms have been taken away for repair. Work to be completed when the weather has improved.

Damaged Bus Shelter

Work has been approved by insurers and Paul Flanders started on Wednesday 1 February.

The existing roof tiles are in a very poor state and not good enough to reuse. The cost of the new tiles is £895 (+VAT) but a sum of £200 (+VAT) has been allowed for the make-up of tiles as required so the additional cost to the Council will be £695 (+VAT). The existing ridge tiles are in good order for reuse.

Office Drains

There is an ongoing problem with blocked toilets in the Old Pavilion. Following work by Mitchell & Mayle Ltd a quote has been received for £2675.00 (+VAT) to re-route existing drains. Additional quote is being sought from Binders Ltd next week. The drains have been cleared by Binders and jetted in the first instance but this has only solved the problem on a temporary basis.

This work is quite urgent as we could find that we have no facilities to use at the Old Pavilion if it is not dealt with quickly.
