Below is a breakdown of the main areas covered by County and District Councils and how you can report any concerns relating to them:

Dog Fouling	Street Cleaning
Fly Tipping	Asbestos
Fly posting	Noise

Potholes	Rights of way
Road/pavement surface	Hedges/trees/weeds along the highway
Flooding	Road workds
