

DRAFT MINUTES – SUBJECT TO CORRECTION AT THE MEETING

Minutes of the meeting of the Highways committee of Waterbeach Parish Council held on Tuesday, 20th November, 2007 at in the New Pavilion, Cambridge Road.

Matters raised by members of the public:

Residents of Denny End Road voiced their opinions on the traffic calming scheme for Denny End Road which had been drawn up by CCC. It was considered that the scheme could be beneficial but it was felt that there was no need for an interactive sign for traffic leaving the village.

3. **To approve Minutes of meeting held on 30th October, 2007:**

Mrs. Smith proposed, seconded by Mr. Johnson and agreed that the minutes be signed.

4. **To consider 2007/2008 Jointly Funded Minor Highway Improvement Scheme proposal for traffic calming in Denny End Road and High Street.**

Mr. Williamson proposed, seconded by Mr. Johnson that the scheme be approved with the amendment that the interactive sign should be positioned as far into the village as possible. 1 abstention.

5. **To consider 2008/2009 Minor Highway Improvement Scheme application for improved pedestrian access in the vicinity of the station and improved provision of dropped kerbs on the major routes to the station from the village:**

The budget for the 2008/09 will be greatly reduced as SCDC are not contributing to the budget. Site visits with CCC officers had been held at the Cambridge Road entrance to the village and at Station Road. The advice received regarding traffic calming at Cambridge Road was that traffic calming and extending the 30mph restriction should be requested as s106 condition of the Cambridge Sports Lake application.

A scheme for improved access to the station from the centre of the village would be submitted to the scheme.
