**2008.26** **To approve the Minutes of the meeting held on 12<sup>th</sup> August**

Mr. Johnson proposed, seconded by Mrs. Smith and agreed that the Minutes be signed.

**2008.27** **To review Jointly Funded Improvement Schemes for:**

i. 2007/2008 scheme

The flashing speed signs in Denny End Road are working although they need adjusting to response correctly. The 20mph flashing signs at the school are still not working.

ii. 2008/2009 scheme

The scheme, to improve pedestrian route, including dropped kerbs, from the station to the centre of the village, is programmed to start in the New Year

iii. 2009/2010 scheme

A scheme for further improvements to pedestrian routes was submitted.

**2008.28** **To consider submission of suggestions for double yellow lines**

It was agreed that the following suggestions for double yellow lines should be put on the web site and on the notice board for consultation:

- Lode Avenue – Adam’s Court corner
- Station Road – outside number 38
- Station Road – opposite St. John’s Close
- Waddelow Road/Denson Close junction – on corner of junction
- Rosemary Road – on sharp left hand bend passed the Dairy
- St. Andrew’s Hill – from Rosemary Road junction to just before driveway to 3 St. Andrew’s Hill
- Telephone exchange corner – from 1 Cambridge Road to the entrance to the car parking area for 5 – 17 Cambridge Road
- Cambridge Road – outside 18 to 28 Cambridge Road
- Cambridge Road – from 62 to the end of the boundary of 64a Cambridge Road
- Greenside East – from junction of Chapel Street to opposite entrance to 10 Greenside
- Greenside North – from 30 Greenside to point of green and equivalent on west side
- High Street/Cattell’s Lane – from entrance to Whittons Farm to 7 Cattell’s Lane
- Bannold Road – from 38 High Street to entrance to Merton Park (28 -34 High Street)
- Bannold Road/Cody Road – from vehicular entrance to surgery to sub-station in Bannold Road
- Bannold Road/Way Lane – along boundary of 116 Way Lane
- Pieces Lane/Way Lane – round the corner on both sides to one house length
- Chapel Street – restricted parking lines in lay-by opposite Village Sotres
- Remove one car length of double yellow lines between Post Office and Vicarage Close
