#### **20/49 FOOTBALL FUN FACTORY SESSIONS**

It was **AGREED** to grant a request from the Football Fun Factory to use the Recreation Ground (and pavilion toilets) between August 3-7<sup>th</sup> and August 24-28 for holiday sessions, subject to a maximum of 40 children per session plus appropriate number of coaches. The fee would be comparable to the rate normally charged at its usual venue at the barracks (currently not suitable as largely indoors).
